HALLOWEEN

Halloween is All Hallows' Eve, which falls on 31st October and refers to the day before All Saints' Day (November 1st). For many years in the northern hemisphere, many different festivals have been associated with gathering in the harvest, preparing for winter, remembering loved ones who have died, and preparing for longer nights and winter cold.

Halloween celebrations are increasingly becoming part of British/Western secular culture. However, many Christian groups, including churches and individual parents/carers do not agree with any involvement by adults or children in Halloween celebrations.

Our considered school approach is not to engage with Halloween based activities in our community. At the same time, we do not actively discourage children's involvement in such activities.

All Saints' Day is a major Christian festival within the Anglican tradition and we recognise and may celebrate this in school. We aim to emphasise the positive celebration of these two days rather than the recognition of Halloween.

We hope that this statement is clear and we welcome any queries or concerns to be raised with us at the earliest opportunity.


