Home / School Agreement

Together we will –

- Support your child and help him or her to achieve a complete education within a Christian environment of caring, sharing and learning.
- Encourage your child to be an active and responsible member of the school.
- Implement any SEND support which may be required to enable the child to succeed in his or her learning.

As a school we will –

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of your child.
- Provide a safe place for learning.
- Be open and welcoming, and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life and worship of the school.
- Provide regular information about school events and your child's progress.
- Only authorise absence in exceptional circumstances, children should always be in school
- Ensure that appropriate medical intervention is provided, should it be deemed necessary by the teacher. Parents and carers will always be kept informed.

As an Astbury Parent/ Carer I will -

- Make sure my child attends regularly and notify the school as early as possible on the day of absence.
- Make sure my child is punctual. The school gate opens at **8:45 am**. Children should be in the classroom by 8:55 am. Any child that is not marked on the register by 9.00 am will be classed as late and the register marked with a L. If children are frequently late then the Education Welfare Officer will become involved.
- Support the school's policies, including school uniform.
- Attend open evenings.
- Read with my child on a regular basis, recorded at least 3 times per week.
- Support Astbury's involvement in the community by attending May Day and services held out of school hours at Astbury Church which include pupil participation.
- Ensure my child has appropriate clothing for all lessons (inc. PE Kit).

My success depends on me and as pupil at Astbury St. Mary's I will -

- Work hard to do my best at all times whilst learning.
- Complete my homework on time and hand it in.
- Read at home.
- Treat others and their property with respect and dignity.
- Listen and follow instructions.
